



### MUSEUMS

In Zagarolo you can visit the Museo del giocattolo, and it collection of toys from the first half of the 19th century up to the present day. The Museum is located in Palazzo Rospigliosi, an historic building from XVI century. Don't miss the National Archeologic Museum in Palestrina (see more details further on)

### HIKING

From Castel San Pietro Romano (a beautiful village 12 km from here) you can reach the Cannucceta Valley, a circular route in an enchanted place declared a Natural Monument. The complete ring is 8 km walk You can download the app Komoot for hiking paths in the Castelli Romani Regional Park

### Places TO SEE

### VILLA ADRIANA -TIVOLI (20 MIN)

Built between 118 and 138 A.D. by the Emperor Hadrian in a lush oasis near Tivoli, the ancient Tibur, Villa Adriana has been declared a **World Heritage Site by UNESCO** in 1999 https://villae.cultura.gov.it/en/the-locations/villa-adriana/

### VILLA D'ESTE -TIVOLI (30 MIN)

Built during the Italian Renaissance, the Villa has been declared **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. A masterpiece of Italian garden design with fountains, nymphaea, grottoes, and a organ which produces audible effects created by water https://villae.cultura.gov.it/en/the-locations/villa-deste/

### VILLA GREGORIANA -TIVOLI (30 MIN)

Villa Gregoriana is a park located at the foot of Tivoli's ancient acropolis. It consists mainly of thick woodland with paths that lead to the small circular Roman Temple of Vesta, the caves of Neptune and the Sirens, which form part of a series of gorges and cascades, and to the

### NATIONAL ARCHEOLOGIC MUSEUM - PALESTRINA (15 MIN)

Located in Palazzo Barberini the Museum display the most important artifacts from ancient Praeneste, one of the main cities of ancient Latium. Prominent is the mosaic of the Nile, among the most remarkable Hellenistic mosaics to have come down to us

### PARCO ARCHEOLOGICO DEL TUSCOLO (30 MIN)

The fulcrum of the Cultural Archaeological Park are the remains of the **ancient Latin city of Tusculum**. Built around the 10th century BC. Tusculum quickly became one of the most important cities of the Latin League. Defeated by the Romans in 496 BC, under the dominion of Rome the city and the surrounding territory became the favorite summer residence of emperors, senators and men of letters



### SANTUARIO DELLA FORTUNA PRIMIGENIA -PALESTRINA (15 MIN)

The Sanctuary of Fortuna Primigenia is the greatest example of Hellenistic architecture in Italy. Today we have evidence of its grandiose remains, in a structure consisting of a series of artificial terraces connected by ramps

### CATTEDRALE DI ANAGNI (45 MIN)

Anagni is best known as "the city of the Popes". The Cathedral, built in the XI century, host a Museum and the **Cripta di San Magno**, also known as "The Sistine Chapel of the Middle Ages". Twelve columns identify twenty-one vaults which, with their respective walls, are decorated with a pictorial cycle of exceptional beauty. In Anagni you can also visit Palazzo Bonifacio VII and the historical center of the city




### **DAILY TRIPS**

### Places within an hour and a half by car

### GIARDINO DI NINFA & CASTELLO DI SERMONETA (1.15 HS)

A romantic English garden that envelops what remains of the ancient city of Ninfa - property of the Caetani Family, destroyed in 1382. At the end of the 19th century, after a period of abandon. Ada Bootle Wilbraham, wife of Onoraro Caetani, created a garden in anglo-saxon style. In the same day you can also visit the Caetani Castle. Located in the medieval village of Sermoneta, its origins date back to the 13th century



This city located in Umbria and perched on a tuff cliff is undoubtedly worth a visit. The Cathedral (1290) with its mosaic gothic façade houses a marble sculpture of the Pietà and is one of the greatest architectural masterpieces of the late Middle Ages. St. Patrick's Well (16th century) is an incredible work of architecture created to guarantee the water supply. You can also visit the Moro Tower and take a tour of the underground Orvieto





### VITERBO (1.15 HS)

You can walk through San Pellegrino, one of the largest medieval neighborhoods in the world, or visit one of the many monuments of this city, like the Popes' Palace (Palazzo dei Papi, 13th century) or the Duomo (San Lorenzo Cathedral, 12th century)

### SABAUDIA - CIRCEO (1.30 HS)

If you feel like you want a beach day, you can go to Sabaudia-Circeo. In this area you can also make some trekking (on the Circeo Mountain), or visit the villages of Sabaudia, San Felice Circeo or Sperlonga (15 minutes away), where you can also visit the archeological site of the Villa di Tiberio with the spectacular Tiberius cave





### **DAILY TRIPS**

### Places within 1.30 - 2 hours by car

### CERVETERI (I.15 HS)

The town of Cerveteri is one of the richest historical centers in Lazio from an artistic and archaeological point of view.

In Cerveteri you can also visit "La Banditaccia", one of the largest necropolises of the ancient world. Crossed by a burial road more than 2 km long, it developed from the 9th century BC. Together with the Necropolis "dei Monterozzi" in Tarquinia it has been declared by UNESCO a world heritage site



### TARQUINIA (I.45 HS)

The oldest archaeological evidence of Tarquinia dates back to the 12th century BC, but the city began to flourish in the 8th century BC, becoming the richest Etruscan city. Today the historic center of Tarquinia is a small medieval jewel surrounded by walls and towers. In Tarquinia you can visit the Etruscan National Museum and the Etruscan necropolis "di Monterozzi" (UNESCO world heritage site) with around 6,000 burials. Around 200 burials contain a series of frescoes



### ROCCA CALASCIO (2 HS)

Rocca Calascio is a charming village of medieval origins which stands on a hill at 1460 meters above sea level. It hosts a fortress that was built around the 12th century. The Fortress and the village are now abandoned, but are so charming that were the set for movies like Lady Hawke. Today the site can be visited for free, along with the Santa Maria della Pietà Church. From up there it is also possible to admire one of the most evocative panoramas of Abruzzo which includes the main mountain groups of the Apennines



### TUSCANIA (1.45 HS)

Tuscania, is one of the most picturesque centers of Tuscia. Characterized by the ancient traces of the Etruscan civilization and the medieval architecture that make it a timeless village. There are numerous religious architectures to visit in Tuscania, starting from the famous Church of San Pietro which stands out from what was once the site of the Etruscan acropolis. Worthy of note is the Abbey of San Giusto, about 4 km south of Tuscania, located in the Marta river valley

### OSTERIA SAINT MARTIN

This is a top quality restaurant, with a wonderful terrace on the valley and sunset. The staff is young and very well prepared. The cuisine mixes and explores tradition and contemporaneity, and is based on Italian dishes with an oriental taste

The oldest restaurant in Zagarolo. Their speciality is the amatriciana, creamed directly at the table inside a wheel of Pecorino Romano cheese. Typical regional cuisine, fish, meat, pizza
